At a glance:

- Utilizing visual, page, and report-level filters, including Top N filtering and date hierarchies.
- Exploring matrix visuals, maps, AI charts (Q&A, word cloud, decomposition), and clustering techniques.
- Understanding the differences between Power BI Desktop and Service, publishing reports, and creating dashboards from reports/tiles.


